

SPRING 2024

We hope you had a lovely Christmas break and are raring to go for the new term! To help you have a better idea of what your child is doing at school, these are some of the topics we will be covering

this term.

English

In English we will be using our focus book 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna. This book is about a family that migrates to another country due to war. We will be writing a letter based on this book. Poetry week will be based on tornados.

For **Spring 1** our topic is **Food**

Maths

We will be continuing to use the Maths Mastery approach, focusing this half term on fractions. Children will be using lots of practical resources to further develop their fraction knowledge.

In multiplication and division we will be continuing to practice key times tables skills.

Science

In Science this half term we are looking at the human skeleton, animal skeletons and how nutrition is important for a healthy body.

Geography

We are learning about mega cities. We will identify what mega cities are and explore population growth.

DT

In DT we are exploring different types of bread products. We will be designing and making our own bread rolls.



For Spring 2 our topic is Our Local Area

English

Our book focus this half term will be the tradition tale: Hansel and Gretel. The children will be writing their own playscript based on this book.

Maths

We will continue to develop our understanding of fractions by recognising and drawing equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator (5/7 + 1/7 = 6/7 and 6/8 - 5/8 = 1/8), and comparing and ordering different fractions.



Next half term we are exploring different parts of plants and finding the best conditions for a plant to grow.

Geography

We are focusing on our local area and its geographical features.



Art

In Art we are doing an artist study of Georgia O'Keeffe. We will be doing our own artwork replicating the styles that Georgia O'Keeffe uses.
