Summer 1—Beyond the great wall!

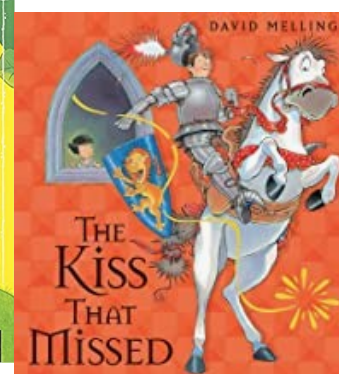
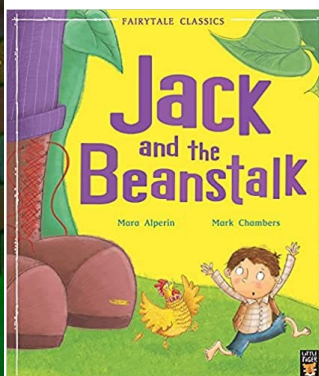
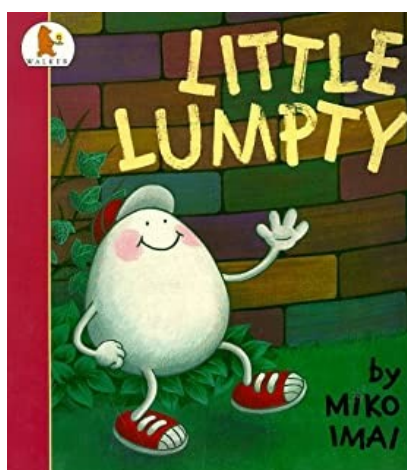
Stories & Rhymes	Ideas for home
