How can families help? Encourage good reading habits, visit the library, **limit time** on mobile devices and computers, ban smart phones at bedtime (this is also safeguarding your child), and talk to children about what they are reading. Some children who say they don't like reading just haven't found the right genre or author yet!

We are asking parents and carers to support their child to read 20 exciting books in 2020, in addition to their school home reader. There is a focus on different genres – types of story – e.g. suspense, fantasy, mystery etc. There will be prizes and treats 😊

*To imagine.

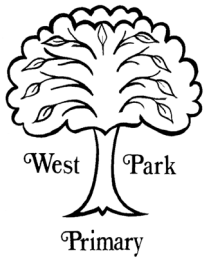
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
